- (i) Identify relevant novel research topic in/around geomorphology
- (ii) Specify a core question
- (iii) Estimate where a topic team could rank in terms of publications and prior projects on a national and international level (i.e., leading group, rising stars etc...),
- (iv) Define interfaces with neighboring disciplines, and
- (v) Suggest appropriate funding schemes e.g. Forschergruppe, Bündel, EU, BMBF...
